- SG contributions are due by 28 October – these are for the July to September 2007 quarter.
- Remember - if you are using The Superannuation Clearing House you should send your contributions and data before October 19, so funds can be distributed before the SG deadline.

BPAY and Direct Debit now available

For a fast and easy way to make contributions, Accountants Super now offers two more payment options: BPAY and Direct Debit. We will soon be writing to all employers outlining these changes.

In short, you can now just send your contributions data to us by email, fax or post and then choose to use BPAY to make your payment, or let us handle the payment via a Direct Debit arrangement. Alternatively, you can use eSuper for Employers to submit your data and payment in one easy step.

To get started, you will need your unique BPAY Reference Number. Alternatively, you will need to complete a Direct Debit Authority Form to establish payments by that method. Our details for EFT transactions are also changing.
